What We're Learning

This month we'll create holiday-themed crafts like making ornaments and paper trees, enjoy sensory play with Christmas-themed bins, and math and literacy activities such as counting ornaments and matching letters. Other options are singing carols, creating cards, and participating in seasonal games like "Jingle and Seek"

1. Letter recognition and sounds for M, N, O
2. Number recognition for 8, 9, 10
3. Emotional Intelligence practices such as empathy
4. Mindfulness practices such as deep breathing when upset; acknowledging and stating how we feel in the moment- bringing awareness to the present when big feelings arise.
